Pastoral Insight

According to Pope Francis, it is the frontline health care workers and essential workers who hold a place of pride among the people who have exemplified the finest manifestations of the human spirit during the pandemic.

The Pope refers to these as the "crucified people", especially the doctors, nurses, religious sisters and priests who have died in the frontlines like soldiers. He refers to these people as 'soldiers of love' and 'bedside angels'

Gratitude, appreciation, affection, and recognition are the dominant terms in the pope's vocabulary when he speaks of doctors and nurses and people who provide critical services.

Sacrament of Penance Programme

Thanks to the great majority of families who have been so responsive to the programme's requirements. For this weekend, parents and carers are able to collect a 'help sheet' for the second chapter. And Holy Cards – that contain the words of the Act of Contrition – will be distributed to the children. Parish School of Religion

For Catholic Children in Government and other Non-Catholic Private Schools

Ash Wednesday is on 2nd March in 2022, meaning that the First Sunday of Lent is 6th March.

From Monday in the First Week of Lent, the Parish School of Religion will commence if families outside of the Catholic schools have children who are interested. It's envisaged that there will be a block of four weeks each term in the Heritage Hall at Camden. Each class is 40 minutes. Parents may sit outside or sit very quietly without conversing at the other end of the Heritage Hall. Unlike the sacramental workshops, adults will not participate in classes. Food and drink are not permitted within the HH at this time.

If there's no interest, then the programme will be withdrawn. If there's minimal interest, classes may be combined.

Parents will be asked to commit for the duration of one term only, and not the entire year. So the commitment is only four weeks. Each commitment can be renewed on a 'term by term' basis.

Enrolments in our Catholic Schools

Please be mindful that application for enrolments for kindergarten in 2023 will be available within about a week. Suggest checking school websites for more information or ring during school office hours. Good idea to check the Magdalene website if children are now in upper primary.

Please be extra mindful that all our Catholic schools in the parish receive more applications that places available. To avoid serious disappointment, it's most necessary to collect an application form as soon as they become available.

Sacrament of Baptism

Phone calls to our parish office most welcome. Currently, to avoid overcrowding, the number of baptisms each Sunday is limited to 8. Each family is then assigned its own block of pews.

FAQ: How long does it take? Some parents are also lining up a local restaurant. With eight children to be baptised, it's best to allow an hour for the ceremony even though it may not take that long. Bookings at about 12:30 PM for one of the local establishments is reasonably safe. And by then, after attending Mass and baptisms, many of the gentlemen are ready for a loosener.
