Pope Francis on War

VATICAN CITY — Pope Francis has again lamented the war in Ukraine and appealed for peace more than a month after Russia's invasion.

"Enough. Stop it. Silence the weapons. Move seriously toward peace," Pope Francis said again in remarks after the Sunday Angelus March 27.

Speaking to a crowd of some 30,000 people gathered in St. Peter's Square on Sunday, the Pope said more than a month had passed since "the beginning of this cruel and senseless war that, like every war, represents a defeat for everyone, for every one of us."

"We need to reject war, a place of death where fathers and mothers bury their children, where men kill their brothers and sisters without even having seen them, where the powerful decide and the poor die."

The Pope noted reports that half of all children in Ukraine have been displaced due to the invasion.

"This means destroying the future, causing dramatic trauma in the smallest and most innocent among us," he said. "This is the bestiality of war – a barbarous and sacrilegious act!"

Palm Sunday

Parish Pastoral Renewal (PPC)

After a tough couple of years, the Church now needs to have an openness to the transforming power of the Holy Spirit to bring new energy and freshness to our parishes.

So, in about three months, initiatives will be taken to form a new Parish Pastoral Council. Membership is open to all our parishioners, especially to those who are able to attend the scheduled meetings that will be held about once every two months. In the absence of a formalised partnership between Camden and The Oaks, the PPC can only apply to Camden at this time.

A PPC is a wonderful way for parishioners to make a contribution towards the operation of the parish and to provide clergy with a range of different opinions. Over the years, initiatives such as:

- ✓ the LCD screens in the chapel,
- ✓ the original projectors in the church,
- ✓ the Welcome Folder available to new parishioners,
- ✓ topics for discussion at the Lent Event and the Advent Event (parish meals in the Heritage Hall)

all had their origin from ideas and discussion presented at the PPC. And it was actually because of a bit of nudging from one PPC member that the books used in the sacramental programmes were upgraded to the present quality.

Another most appealing feature about membership is that the optional conviviality after a meeting is sometimes longer than the actual meeting. More news in coming months but please consider. Would be good to have a dozen motivated parishioners.
