## **From Pope Francis ~ Empty Nets**

The Gospel on the Third Sunday of Easter was about how the disciples – after the Resurrection of Jesus – were unsure of their future and returned to the former occupation as fishermen. Jesus tracked them down at a time when they had been fishing all night but caught nothing. They had empty nets.

The Pope suggested that Peter was disheartened and sought to return to his former life.

"And what does Jesus do?" Pope Francis recounted. "He returns again to the shore of the lake where he had chosen Peter, Andrew, James and John. He does not reproach them but calls the disciples tenderly: 'children."

"Then he invites them, as before, to cast their nets again, courageously. And this time the nets are filled to overflowing," said the Pope.

"It can happen to us, out of tiredness, disappointment, perhaps out of laziness, to forget the Lord and to neglect the great choices we have made, to be content with something else.

"For example, we do not devote time to talking to each other in the family, preferring personal pastimes; we forget prayer, letting ourselves be wrapped up in our own needs; we neglect charity, with the excuse of daily urgencies."

"But, in doing so, we find ourselves disappointed: with empty nets, like Peter."

"Brothers, sisters, when our nets are empty in life, it is not the time to feel sorry for ourselves, to have fun, to return to old pastimes. It is the time to start again with Jesus, to find the courage to begin again, to set out with him,"

## **Confirmation Programme**

The Confirmation programme is now a little smaller than originally expected. About 90% of enrolment forms were returned last weekend with the mandatory offering of \$25. Thanks. The remaining 10% are now presumed to have voluntarily withdrawn. The Bishop's Office will be notified this coming week to be advised that five ceremonies will no longer be required.

For the 90% who have now confirmed their registration and commitment to Mass, books can be collected this week. Please first see Father Michael after Mass near the baptism font to collect the 'help sheet' and then venture to the parish meeting room to collect a personalised book. The first chapter needs to be completed this week, and parents and carers need to be especially mindful of completing their own reading on page 3.
