Pastoral Insight for Youth

In the recently convened European Union Youth Conference, taking place in Prague, Czech Republic, Pope Francis sent a message inviting young people "to look upwards and beyond, to keep seeking the real meaning of your life, where you come from and where you are going, and the Truth, because we cannot live authentically if we do not seek the Truth."

Though Ukraine is not part of the European Union, Francis urged the young adults taking part in the conference to commit themselves to promoting peace and the end of the war.

He said: "it is legitimate to rebel" in cases like this, "where, as usual, a few powerful people decide and send thousands of young people to fight and die."

The Pope recalled that someone once said that "if the world were ruled by women, there would not be so many wars, because those who have the mission of giving life cannot make death choices."

"In a similar vein, I like to think that if the world were ruled by young people, there would not be so many wars," he added. "Those who have their whole life ahead of them do not want to ruin it and throw it away, but to live it to the full."

He closed his message by asking young people to be "generous in generating new lives, always and only as the fruit of love."

New Electronic Sign

Many parishioners may have noticed that there's a kind of seasonality to our church year, especially when children are preparing to celebrate the sacraments of Penance, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. And at Sunday Masses in the weeks through Lent and Advent, the number of people attending Mass seems to be a little more than usual. The quieter months tend to be January, July and August.

So the newly installed electronic sign will help to communicate the events of parish life to those who might be walking or driving along John Street. And one of the big advantages will be the listing of Mass times at Easter and Christmas when the sacred ceremonies are different to the normal scheduling.

There's been an emerging phenomenon in society of the way in which, increasingly, people like the convenience of driveby or drive-through services. Hopefully, the new sign will help in this way. And there's lots of potential to be innovative.
