Pastoral Insight on Social Media

Pope Francis has called on Catholics to counter toxicity in social media, and to engage in dialogue and education to help deal with "lies and misinformation."

In a message published by the Holy See on 18 July 2022, the Holy Father also called for the inclusion of currently excluded communities into "the digital space."

Pope Francis said, "the use of digital media, especially social media, has raised a number of serious ethical issues that call for wise and discerning judgment on the part of communicators and all those concerned with the authenticity and quality of human relationships."

"Sometimes and in some places, media sites have become places of toxicity, hate speech and fake news," the pope added.

He encouraged Catholic communicators to persevere in efforts to counter these, "paying particular attention to the need to assist people, especially young people, to develop a sound critical sense, learning to distinguish truth from falsehood, right from wrong, good from evil, and to appreciate the importance of working for justice, social concord, and respect for our common home."

In doing so, Catholic communicators provide a "significant contribution to the spread of a culture of peace grounded in the truth of the Gospel," the Holy Father added.

Catholic Enrichment for Adults ~ Next Meeting 27 July 2022

Our programme continues to develop with special emphasis on weekly presence at Mass, midweek reading and discussion in groups. This coming meeting looks at interesting topics including Pentecost and the early Church. All welcome.

Sacrament of Penance ~ Backup Programme.

After Masses this weekend, the children are asked to assemble before the sanctuary for a few moments. There needs to be a check to ensure that they know the Act of Contrition perfectly.

Parents and carers need to also assist the children in the examination of their consciences. Here's a sample of sins that might be committed by children:

Lying, stealing, cruelty to others, talking back to parents, disobedience, cheating, over-eating, envious of the possessions of other kids, resisting a bath when dirty, temper tantrums, being unbelievably precious, negligence to personal pets, pouting, being stubborn about going to Mass when other family members are going, hurtful words, ignoring little brothers and little sisters, impatience with others.

One of the objectives of the penance programme is for children to begin developing a moral framework which is in keeping with the teachings of the Catholic Church. In the examination of conscience, parents and carers should dedicate time to the children in the days leading up to their first confession.

The idea is to help the children identify their sins without actually extracting a confession from them. The confession should be kept for the priest where it remains 100% confidential. The seal of confession is absolute.

Please ensure that the children can recite the Act of Contrition perfectly.
