In last week's edition of the Catholic Weekly (page 2), there was a commentary about a new approach to chaplaincy at Notre Dame Catholic University.

Four words were used to describe this new approach: Commitment, Prayer, Mentoring and Mission.

Under this chaplaincy, a new programme has been introduced, entitled: *In Altum*, ("into the deep"). One of the university students, Ms Molly Hayes, remarked that before the *In Altum*, she attended Mass regularly but now prays daily and enjoys spiritual reading.

"The habits we got from *In Altum* have been so transferable for me. Prayer especially". She said: "I made a commitment to prayer, and I've kept that commitment now."

The programme coordinator said: "You have to be responsible before God! Ultimately this is a programme around mission, and there's no mission without prayer".
