#### Extract from Most Reverend Brian Mascord, Bishop of Wollongong:

Now that the authorities have removed restrictions, it is appropriate to revoke diocesan restrictions:

- 1. Holy Day Dispensation ~ reinstated
- 2. Receiving the Eucharist "on the tongue" now permitted from the priest only, but please come to the priest and towards the end of the line.
- 3. Holy Water stoups ~ now being refilled with water changed weekly; unused water tipped onto church gardens.
