Sacrament of Penance Programme 2022/2023

Parents/carers are invited to enroll their children in the Penance Programme. Children must have been baptised and be in at least Year 2 in 2022, and be going into at least Year 3 in 2023. Children younger than this cannot be accepted into the programme.

The initial weekend is 26/27 November 2022 at all Masses at The Oaks, Oakdale and Camden.

If interested in enrolling, please be mindful of the requirement for parents/carers and their children to have a weekly presence at Sunday Mass. Family members need to be committed and motivated.

If intending to be away on holidays during the programme – December, February, March – please leave enrolment until another time. However, in recognition that everyone needs to have a well-deserved holiday, the programme is not administered from Christmas until the end of January. Comprehensive details will be contained in a programme timeline that will be distributed on 26/27 November.

The opportunity is still available for parishioners to include the names of deceased family members and friends among those names on the Table of Prayerful Remembrance before the altar in St Paul's Church. Names can be placed in any of the collection bags or delivered to the parish office during our normal midweek business hours.

Catholic Enrichment

Very special ceremony on Saturday 12th December at 10:00 AM Mass. There are adults to be baptised and many others to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church by reception of Confirmation and First Holy Communion. The prayerful best wishes of the whole parish accompany our catechumenates at this time. Our usual 9:00 AM Mass has been cancelled for this week only but those who normally attend this Mass are asked to attend the 10:00 AM Mass to offer prayerful support.

Mass Counts in November

A random selection of parishioners -8 in total for each Mass - will be invited to count at the Offertory the people who are present at Mass. The idea is that each counter tallies the people in one block of pews and writes the answer. Hopefully, everything will go ok.
