A new year had begun and various financial details from the previous year had just become available. Parishioners were advised at Mass that a personalised envelope with their 'giving details' had been provided on a table in the foyer to the side entrance of the small church.

The Monsignor arrived in Australia in 1928 and his Irish accent had remained as strong as ever, even after more than 60 years. So in the announcements at the end of Mass, the Monsignor advised:

"The 'giving details' are now available for pick-up. To avoid congestion, those who have no need to collect an envelope would be best advised to leave the church through the back door. And those to collect an envelope will need to be leaving through the side door"

He then added with a grin: "And while this is happening, I'll be saying a few little prayers that those who this year are leaving through the back door might next year be able to leave through the side door".

Sacrament of Penance Programme 2022/2023
