#### Sacrament of Penance Programme 2022/2023

After a three-week lead-in during Advent in 2022, the Penance programme paused over the holidays and is soon to resume. Families need to be motivated and have a commitment, especially in having a presence with children at Sunday Mass, which includes the Saturday evening Vigil.

The nurturing of the children's spiritual formation is an act of love. And conversely, it is the forgetfulness of God that can so easily leave people feeling empty, depressed and wandering through life aimlessly.

Your children deserve the best. The Lord Jesus said to his followers: "I am the way, the truth, and the life". Don't be fooled by the fleeing lights of this world. And the quote from the top of the page from St Clare is most worthy of prayerful reflection.

The Penance programme resumes for 2023 next weekend 28/29 January with a required presence at Mass.

#### Parishioners please note: Mass for teachers and ancillary personnel

For almost 20 years, teachers and ancillary personnel from the four schools in our parish have gathered to celebrate Mass together. Quite a beautiful custom.

This coming Friday 27<sup>th</sup> January, the morning Mass at Camden – normally 9:00 AM – will be brought forward to 8:30 AM. Our parishioners are most welcome to attend.

Mass in St Clare's presbytery on that day is cancelled.

At the 8:30 AM, there will be sacred music and a homily from Father Michael. This Mass is an excellent opportunity to offer prayers for the work of our schools over the coming year.

### **Heritage Hall**

Developments had been moving slowly last year. But finally, however, there's been a breakthrough. And a report has been completed to outline the scope of works necessary to overcome problems that emerged when, in the first half of 2022, there had been such a heavy and persistent deluge of rain. Gratitude is extended to the professional people who assisted in the process.

#### The Oaks

Following the preparation of professional reports and extensive consultation over the past 18 months, petition to Bishop Brian was initiated in 2022 to sell the parcel of land adjoining the cemetery.

Permission has been granted and the matter has now been referred to a Project Manager.

There will be more reporting as developments unfold.

### **Baptisms**

As a matter of interest, there were just over 500 baptisms in the parish in 2022, a record for Camden. Hard to imagine there would be too many other parishes in the country with so many.

### **St Clare's New Church**

Following a four-week period of advertising in the Catholic Weekly, there was an unexpectedly large number of responses from architects – that were based locally, interstate and even overseas – offering expressions of interest. Had no idea that the Catholic Weekly would have such reach.

The process is now being further progressed and it is anticipated that a contract between one of these architects and the church will be exchanged by the end of February. Design work will begin immediately.

### **Plots for Sale**

One of our parishioners has two plots for sale at Forest Lawn at a discount for members of our own parish – just \$7,500 for both. This is quite a reasonable offer as plots at St Alovsius, The Oaks cost \$4,000 each. Those interested are welcome to contact the parish office for contact details.
