Please note that the Diocese of Wollongong has again produced a lovely book for Lent. Excellent investment. The name of the book is **Triumph.**

Triumph is an 88-page full colour book (240x170mm) containing short daily reflections (from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday) perfect for individual devotional reading in addition to the longer-form Sunday Scripture readings and reflections, prayers and questions that traditionally form part of Lenten group gatherings. The book also features beautiful religious artworks. Cost just \$5.
