When our parishioners have family members and friends who have reached a great age and are in obvious decline, please notify the parish office. A priest will try to visit as soon as possible. It's best practice to allow a week for the priest to visit. Hopefully that length of time won't be necessary but it will go a long way towards ensuring anointing before death.

If families try to time their notification to the priest and parish office to within a few hours of dying, then there will invariably be disappointment. Priests can be heavily committed especially if away from the parish and/or in instances of funerals.
