Monday 15th July Feast of St Bonaventure

Born in 1218 in Tuscany, he studied philosophy and theology in Paris. He gained his master's degree and was eventually elected as Minister General of the Franciscan Order. He exercised this office with great wisdom and prudence and later became a Cardinal. After writing many influential works, he died in Lyons in 1274. He writes:

As "pride is the beginning of all sin," (Eccl. x, 15) so humility is the foundation of all virtue. Learn to be really humble and not, as the hypocrite, humble merely in appearance.
