Wednesday 14th August

Feast of Saint Maximilian Kolbe

Pope John Paul II called Saint Maximilian a Saint for our troubled age. Saint Maximilian died in Auschwitz concentration camp a casualty of World War 2 in 1941.

Saint Maximilian said:

- 1: Let us not forget that Jesus not only suffered, but also rose in glory; so too we go to the glory of the resurrection by way of suffering and the Cross.
- 2: The Cross is the school of love.
- 3: Do not forget that holiness exists not in extraordinary actions, but in performing your duties towards God, yourself and others, well.
- 4: For Jesus Christ I am prepared to suffer still more.

During the War Saint Maximilian ran a hospital, assisted refugees and sheltered Jews, eventually being arrested and sent to Auschwitz. Saint Maximilian offered himself to save another inmate who was chosen by the Gestapo to be starved to death in a bunker.

Thursday 15th August Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God.

This coming Thursday is a Holy day of Obligation. It is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Morning Mass will be at 9.15am and a special evening Mass will be celebrated at 7.00pm. The school children of Saint Paul's will be in attendance at the morning Mass and Father James will be the celebrant at both the morning and evening Masses.
