#### **Memorial of Saint Monica, Patron Saint of Mothers**

Mother of Saint Augustine one of the most brilliant philosophers and well know Saints of all time. Saint Monica said "I cried to the Lord in my distress and He answered me."

### Memorial of Saint Augustine, Bishop, Doctor

Saint Augustine was born on 13 November 354 in what is now Algeria and died 28 August 430. He was one of the most significant thinkers of the Catholic church, wrote many books, sermons, letters and treatises. He practiced great poverty and supported the poor. His words still give comfort and are often quoted.

### The Passion of Saint John the Baptist, Martyr

Saint John, said "I am baptising you with water but one is coming who will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and I am not fit to undo His sandals". John baptised Jesus in the River Jordan. He is recognised as the fulfillment of a prophesy in Isaiah, a messenger sent ahead to proclaim repentance as a voice crying in the wilderness telling of the coming of the Messiah.
