Saint Gregory the Great, Pope, Doctor

Pope Gregory I was the 64th Bishop of Rome. He is the patron Saint of Musicians and Teachers. Gregory was a Roman Senator's son and Prefect of Rome himself at age 30. He lived in a Monastery he established on his family's estate before becoming a Papal ambassador and then Pope. During his Papacy he improved the conditions of the people of Rome and sent missionaries to England, he revised the Roman worship of the day. He is known as the "Father of Christian Worship" throughout the world and was buried in Saint Peters Basilica in 1606.

Saint Gregory said, "The sacred Scriptures grow with the one who reads them."
