Saint John Chrysostom, Bishop, Doctor

Saint John was born in 347 in Antioch, Syria and died in 407 in what is now Türkiye. Saint John was Archbishop of Constantinople, a posting that was much against his will, he was a great orator renowned for his homilies and much loved by the common people. He was given the surname "Chrysostom" which means "golden mouthed."

Saint John said: "No matter how just your words may be, you ruin everything when you speak with anger."
