Monday 23rd September Saint Pius of Pietrelcina, Priest – remembered as Padre Pio

Known for his piety and charity, Padre Pio will long be remembered for countless spiritual insights, succinct spiritual direction and constant encouragement. Padre Pio said:

"Today's society does not pray. That is why it is falling apart." and "Prayer is the best weapon we possess, the key that opens the heart of God."

Monday 27th September Saint Vincent DePaul, Priest – born in 1581 and died in 1660

A French Catholic priest who dedicated himself to serving the poor. Saint Vincent said:

"We should strive to keep our hearts open to the sufferings and wretchedness of other people, and pray continually that God may grant us the spirit of compassion which is truly the spirit of God."

Sacrament of First Holy Communion

Enrolments for the Sacrament of First Holy Communion have now closed for this year. We will have 235 candidates who will celebrate the sacrament on the Feast of Christ the King in November. This weekend, workbooks will be distributed as well as the first week's assistance sheet. The assistance sheets are offered to parents/carers as a guide. The sheets are not intended to be handed to the children with the comment "here are the answers". One hour a week spent working with your children for the sacrament is the most wonderful opportunity to share your faith as well as quality time. A short form will be distributed within the church after Mass which needs to be filled in, then taken to the doors of the meeting room and exchanged for your child's personalised workbook.

Candidates also need to attend this coming week for their prayer assessment. Children with odd birthday dates will be assessed on Tuesday 24 September at 6.00pm and children with even birthday dates on Thursday 26 September again at 6.00pm. If your family has commitments and you cannot come at your assigned time, you are able to attend either evening, contact should be made with the Parish office if you are unable to attend either and we will endeavour to make a time that is suitable to your family.

Catholic Enrichment programme ~ Wednesday 25 September

We are now more than halfway through our 2024 Catholic Enrichment Programme. We have 24 adults who are taking part in the programme this year. The next evening is on Wednesday 25 September at 7.00pm, the subject is "The Eucharist, Praying the Mass". A reminder is offered to all participants.

Bishop's Annual Appeal

At all Masses this weekend there will be a short video played from Bishop Brian speaking to us about his Annual Appeal. Our faith calls on us to support one another, and our Priests live out this action. As our priests age they require additional support, this appeal gives us all the opportunity to give back to the priests who have supported and prayed for us and with us over many years. The collection will be a leaving collection, and the church wardens will be at all doors as we leave Mass. Father Michael never expects us to support three collections at a time and asks for our discretionary support this weekend to go to the Bishop's Appeal. Appreciation by all the priests is offered in advance.
