Saints Simon and Jude, apostles

Saints Simon and Jude travelled together to Persia where both were martyred. Saint Jude said "Thanks and Giving are the epitome of kindness."

Friday 1st November

All Saints Day

The day the church commemorates all the saints known and unknown, who have attained heaven. All Saints' Day was formally started by Pope Boniface IV, who consecrated the Pantheon in Rome to the Virgin Mary and all the Martyrs on 13 May in 609 AD.

Sacrament of First Holy Communion

This week Parents/Carers will need to assist their child in completing the Fourth and final Workshop, Pages 27 - 34. An assistance sheet will be distributed at all Masses. With the workshop books being returned the following week this would be the time for parents/carers to look at all the completed weekly workshops to ensure that every puzzle and activity has been completed. Books not satisfactorily completed will need to be returned for further work.

A leaflet with the First Holy Communion ceremony allocations will also be distributed. Those families who did not submit a request last weekend will still have the opportunity to select from the ceremonies which still have places available. Please see the attendants and request a form.

All Saints and All Souls Day

This Friday, 1st November, we begin the last month of the Church calendar reflecting on the "last things", including death. We start by celebrating All Saints, where we honour God bringing joy, life, and goodness to the world through the lives of all the saints, especially those "anonymous saints" – people of extraordinary holiness who are with God. There will be Benediction at 8:50am and All Saints Mass will start at 9:15am, with the choir providing music.

All Souls Day, Saturday 2nd November, honours all our loved ones who have passed on, but who cling to their earthly attachments and are pained by their separation. We believe they can be helped by our prayers so that "thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, para 1032). All Masses in November, starting on All Souls, can be offered for the faithful departed. All Souls Day Mass will be at 9am, with the choir providing music.

Early notice of Sunday 24 November 5.00pm Mass change

A Mass for First Holy Communions is scheduled for 4.00pm on Sunday 24 November. Early notice is offered to the regular attendees at the 5.00pm Sunday Mass, for that Sunday only Mass will be at 4.00pm. Regular attendees are still welcome to have a presence. If parishioners would like to avoid the First Holy Communion crowds, the 8.00am and 10.00am Masses will be normal Parish Masses.

Morning Mass ~ New Sound System Installation

Work to install the new sound system being fitted to the church and chapel will commence on Monday morning 28 October. This will mean that the church will be unavailable for Mass probably until Thursday. Morning Mass and Adoration will be held in the Chapel Tuesday and Wednesday. Father James will advise parishioners on how the work is progressing and if this time frame changes we will notify everyone as soon as possible. If in doubt please contact the parish office during normal hours and if we have any further information we will be happy to assist.
