#### Advent Event ~ Saturday Evening 30 November

This wonderful evening of discussion, food and fraternity is rapidly approaching. So what's involved:

- ▶ We gather for the 5:00 PM Vigil Mass which is the first Mass of the Church's new year.
- After Mass, there is movement from the church to the Heritage Hall for complimentary predinner beverages.
- > All people have been assigned to a table, so there's no one left in an awkward situation.
- > All will be greeted by the MC and advise of the proceedings for the evening.
- > Two discussion topics will be presented to the tables.
- About 6:30 PM or soon enough afterwards the buffet meal will be served, with the MC advising of an orderly manner in which our parishioners come to collect the food.
- ➢ After all have returned to their tables with main meal, the MC will call upon a table spokesperson to report upon the first discussion topic.
- > Afterwards, our parishioners then move in an orderly way to collect deserts.
- And then after all the deserts have been collected, the spokespersons report upon the second topic.

Across the evening, all in attendance are welcome to recharge their glasses. There'll be plenty of beer, wine and soft drinks available. Don't like to be caught short. There will NOT be a repeat of what happened at Cana in Galilee.

Almost 70 tickets have been purchased. The maximum number is 90. And it's great news that our teachers from St Paul's and St Clare's have both booked a table.

All are invited and another very enjoyable evening is assured. Bookings just \$20 each. Please register with the parish office.

The formalities conclude about 8:00 PM allowing parishioners an early evening if preferred. Generally, last drinks are served about 8:30 PM. The clergy still have to be at Mass the following morning.
