The Presentation of Blessed Virgin Mary

The feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated annually on the 21 November and commemorates the presentation to the Temple by Joachim and Anne, Mary's parents, of their only daughter. The feast celebrates the faith of Mary's parents and the purity of Mary.

Sacrament of First Holy Communion

This weekend Holy Communion Medals will be blessed and distributed at all weekend Masses. The medals are a gift from the Parish and are worn by the candidates during their ceremony. There are still some completed workbooks needed to be picked up. The books will again be in the chapel on a table and families are asked to please take their book home, and to correct any reworking that has been indicated. Books need not be returned a second time unless requested.

Families are reminded of the midweek Ceremony Rehearsals that will be held this coming week. Tuesday at 5.00pm for the 1.00pm Saturday Mass, Tuesday at 6.00pm for the Saturday 3.00pm Mass, Wednesday 5.00pm for the Saturday 5.00pm Mass, Wednesday 6.00pm for the Sunday 11.30am Mass, and Thursday 5.00pm for the Sunday 4.00pm Mass. Should families have a conflicting commitment it is possible to attend another rehearsal, if this is the case, please do not take a pew at the rehearsal that is not your own but gather in the church where Father will direct you. Your family will be allocated a pew at the correct rehearsal. Please contact the office if you require any further information.

Reminder of Sunday 24 November 5.00pm Mass change

Regular attendees at the 5.00pm Sunday Mass are reminded that next Sunday the 24 November, Mass for that weekend only will be at 4.00pm to include the approximately 50 children who will be making their First Holy Communion. Mass should only be approximately 15 minutes longer, there will be enough room in the church to accommodate anyone who would like to attend. Should your choice be to attend another Mass next weekend both 8.00am and 10.00am will be normal Parish Masses with no First Holy Communion celebrants in attendance. Early Notice of the Sacrament of Penance Programme 2024/2025

Over the first weekend of Advent, 30 November, 1 December names will be taken of children who are currently in year 2 or higher and who will be in year 3 or higher in 2025, who have been baptised and wish to enrol for the Penance Programme of 2024 -2025. As with all our Sacramental programmes the taking of names and distribution of required forms takes place after each of the weekend Masses. It is not necessary to attend the same Mass each weekend and every Mass will have attendants to assist.

Families from the Oaks and Oakdale are asked to indicate their church preference at the time of enrolment. This preference can be changed if needed but it does assist with the timely distribution of forms etc. if we are aware of that families are in attendance at a particular church.
