### **Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

Although celebrated on 8<sup>th</sup> December, the Solemnity in 2024 will be a day later so as to avoid a clash with the Second Sunday of Advent.

The Immaculate Conception is a beautiful church doctrine that teaches that Mary was born without original sin and lived the entirety of her life without any stain of sin.

Accordingly, Mass will be celebrated by Fr James at Camden this

It's just another reason why children in our sacramental programmes are required to learn the Hail Mary.

And it's why - in our midweek Masses at St Clare's and St Paul's - the Angelus is recited before Mass.
