# Dear Parishioners at Camden and The Oaks

#### 4th Sunday of Easter ~ 11th May 2025

#### Habemus Papam ~ We Have a New Pope

Pope Leo XIV, born Robert Francis Prevost, was elected as the 267<sup>th</sup> Pope of the Catholic Church on 8 May 2025. He is the first American to hold the position and the first Augustinian Pope since Gregory VIII.

Born in Chicago Illinois 1955, he spent decades serving in Peru where he became a bishop and later a cardinal.

Before his election, he was the Prefect for the Dicastery of Bishops overseeing the selection of bishops worldwide. His papal motto, In illo Uno unum ("In the One, one"), reflects his commitment to unity.

Upon his election, he addressed the crowd at St. Peter's Basilica with the words, "Peace be with all of you". His leadership is expected to focus on missionary work, dialogue and social justice. Here are some other key aspects of his leadership:

- Commitment to Peace: His first words as Pope were about peace, being an early indication of his dedication to global harmony.
- Name Choice: By selecting *Leo XIV*, he signals a commitment to the social teachings of the Church, similar to Pope Leo XIII, who advocated for workers' rights.
- Background: He is the first American Pope and has dual citizenship in Peru, where he served as a missionary for decades.
- Leadership Style: He values humility and closeness to the people, stating that bishops should not act as "little princes" but rather walk alongside their communities.

His papacy is expected to continue the progressive approach of Pope Francis while maintaining traditional Church doctrine.
