Spiritual Insight

Last week's spiritual insight made reference to a little of the content from John Shea's book "To Dare The Our Father. Here's a second a final reference.

The author recalls something of his own professional experience from years earlier when he was facilitating groups for the purpose of faith sharing. Presumably, the people present in these groups have some commitment to Mass. So the questions is raised:

What is your favourite part of the Mass?

Not unexpectantly, a few people say quickly and with a touch of humour "the end".

But more discerningly, many other parts are nominated – "Hearing the Word of God', 'Receiving Holy Communion', 'Homily' 'Sign of Peace', 'Our Father'. And in addition to the various prayers, actions and liturgical moments were also cited.

There's no doubt that in churches where sacred music has a life-giving ministry, many parishioners may well select their favourite part of the Mass in terms that relate to singing or perhaps – in the case of a Cathedral – an organ recital at Thanksgiving.

Well in further facilitating the group, Shea then asks a follow-up question which is a little tougher. He asks for the reason(s) why the respondents chose the answers they did.

After hearing the answers, Shae then makes the following observation "People were not as articulate with this question, but a common characteristic was that at their favourite part of the liturgy their participation sharpened. There was a heightened engagement, a sense that they were included in something larger and important" (p. xiv). Great insight!

Our parishioners are encouraged to reflect upon these two questions, as well as pray the Our Father.

Parents may also be interested in directing these questions to their older children and teenagers.
