It will be my own solemn duty to advise parents and carers if their names have been withdrawn and to explain why. Rather unfortunately, this has been necessary a few times in previous programmes over the past eight months.

National Count of Attendance

From Bishop Brian:

"The 2021 National Count of Attendance (Mass Count) will take place over the first four weekends in May (starting 1 May 2021). The Diocese of Wollongong has just received the instructions and forms for the national Mass count. Importantly, I note that this is a count of attendance at all Masses celebrated in the diocese, including all parishes, non-parish centres, hospitals and chaplaincies".

Also, could be a really good idea if as many parishioners as possible could try to make a big effort to be at one of our many Masses each weekend during the month of May. Don't want to be assessed as parishes (Camden and The Oaks) in sharp decline. Otherwise, I might get the sack!

The good news is that for the first three weeks, a count will not be necessary as our parishioners will have registered in advance. For the final week, we're not so lucky because there needs to be a break-up of numbers in terms of age brackets.

So for this final weekend, a count will take place after Holy Communion in the following way:
